# "A Faithful Daughter of God and of Aaron!!"

<sup>A1</sup> There was in the Days of Herod, the King of Judea, a Certain Priest named *Zacharias*, of the Division of Abijah. His Wife was of the Daughters of Aaron, and Her name was *Elizabeth*. And,

B1 They were Both <u>Righteous</u> before God,
Walking in All the <u>Commandments</u> C1
and (Walking in All the) <u>Ordinances</u> C2
B2 of the Lord Blameless.

<sup>A2</sup> But, *They* had no child, because *Elizabeth* was *barren*, & *They* were both *well advanced in years*.

So it was, that while He was Serving as Priest before God in the Order of his Division, According to the Custom of the Priesthood, His Lot fell to burn incense when He went into the Temple of the Lord. And the whole multitude of the people was praying outside at the Hour of Incense (for the Evening Offering). Then An Angel of the Lord appeared to Him, standing on the Right Side of the Altar of Incense. And when Zacharias saw Him, He was troubled, and fear fell upon Him. But the Angel said to Him, "Do not be afraid, Zacharias, for Your Prayer is Heard; and Your Wife Elizabeth will bear You a Son, and You shall call His name, John. And You will have joy and gladness, and many will rejoice at His birth. For He will be great in the Sight of the Lord, and shall drink neither wine nor strong drink. He will also be Filled with the Holy Spirit, even from His Mother's womb. And He will turn many of the Children of Israel to the Lord Their God. He will also go before Him in the Spirit & Power of Elijah, 'To Turn The Hearts of the Fathers to the Children', and the Disobedient to the Wisdom of the Just, to Make Ready a People Prepared for the Lord!" And Zacharias said to the Angel, "How shall I know this? For I am an old Man, and My Wife is well advanced in years." And the Angel answered Him, "I am Gabriel, Who stands in the Presence of God, and was sent to speak to You and bring to You these Glad Tidings. But behold, You will be mute and not able to speak until the day these things take place, because You did not believe My Words which will be fulfilled in their own time!" And the people waited for Zacharias, and marveled that He lingered so long in the Temple. But when He came out, He could not speak to them; and they perceived that He had seen a Vision in the Temple, for He beckoned to them and remained speechless. So it was, as soon as the days of His service were completed, that He departed to His own house. Now after those days, His Wife Elizabeth Conceived; and She hid herself five months, saying, "The Lord has dealt with Me, in the days when He looked on Me, to take away My reproach among the people!" Luke 1:5-25

Now in the sixth month the *Angel Gabriel* was sent by *God* to a City of Galilee Named Nazareth, to a *Virgin* betrothed to a Man whose name was *Joseph*, of the House of David. The *Virgin's* Name was *Mary*. And having come in, the *Angel* said to Her, "Rejoice, Highly Favored One, the Lord Is With You; Blessed Are You Among Women!" But when She saw Him, She was troubled at His Saying, and considered what manner of greeting this was. Then the *Angel* said to Her, "Do Not Be Afraid, Mary, For You Have Found Favor With God. And Behold, You Will Conceive in Your Womb and Bring Forth a Son, and Shall Call His Name Jesus. He Will Be Great, and Will Be Called the Son of the Highest; and the Lord God Will Give Him the Throne of His Father David.
